What: Grand Opening of electric car Superchargers in Lincoln

More: For the past number of months Tesla Motors has installed electric car charging stations (<https://www.tesla.com/supercharger>) all over the world. In the United States there are 350 locations with 4 to 12 Supercharger plugs each for charging multiple cars at the same time. This month Lincoln was added to that list, along with Grand Island, Gothenburg and Ogallala recently. This is important since it allows travel from one coast to the other through Nebraska on I-80. Tesla vehicles have over 200 miles of range. Lincoln's Hy Vee on N 27th street is a very important location on that route. A Supercharger will charge a Tesla electric car in less than an hour - about the time it takes to have a coffee and a restroom break or to eat lunch. Lincoln and Nebraska are now on the Supercharger Superhighway!

A few electric car devotees are putting together a Grand Opening for the 8 Superchargers in North Lincoln.

City Councilman Carl Eskridge and Nebraska Lt. Gov. Mike Foley and other Influential people in Nebraska and Lincoln will join us to welcome this new, modern, and non-polluting form of transportation at a Grand Opening this Friday at the Superchargers at the SW corner of the Hy Vee parking lot.

The CEO of LES and the manager of Hy Vee at the location will be in attendance. A number of Tesla electric cars will be there and rides will be given to attendees so they can experience these exciting new electric cars.
